

## Capital Improvements:

Your contributions to our parish help maintain the facility, making it the center of prayer in our community. Over the last three years, we have completed the sealing of the exterior church, made minor parking lot improvements, relocated the tabernacle, installed new lighting in the vestibule and sanctuary, repaired sidewalks and steps around the church, landscaped parish grounds, painted the entranceways and bathrooms of the parish center, repaired the parish center roof drains, and replaced the fence at the parish cemetery, as well as placed a statue of Mary overlooking the cemetery. Currently we are undertaking the scheduling of plaster and paint repair of the church. It is my hope that this will be completed next year.
